Experience historic Hampshire, a nostalgic railway, Jane Austen heritage, an iconic gin distillery & the New Forest.

Day 1: We journey to our The Hampshire Court Hotel - making comfort stops en route.

Day 2: Explore the historic streets of King Alfred's ancient capital of England, **Winchester**. Visit the Great Hall and King Arthur's Round Table, a fully restored working water mill and Winchester Cathedral, where Jane Austen is buried. Based at Laverstoke Mill, **the Bombay Sapphire Distillery** is in a conservation area with over 1000 years of history. The distillery showcases the care, skill and artistry behind every drop of Bombay Sapphire, and allows you to discover the flavours of the botanicals

which make this gin so unique.

Day 3: Excursion to the wonderfully scenic **New Forest National Park**, with its wild horses, picturesque towns and villages, idyllic glades and historic woodland. We include a visit to **Beaulieu, home to the National Motor Museum, Palace House & Gardens, Beaulieu Abbey and World of Top Gear**, with unlimited rides on the Monorail and veteran bus.

Day 4: We head to the historic town of **Bishop's Waltham**, which was selected by the bishops from Winchester Cathedral as the site of their palace in the 12th century. This afternoon we
