You will be guided through the Historic Dockyard by your very own costumed Midwife, armed with a photograph book and tales of their 'sisters', before being allowed to explore the sets, costumes and props in the all-new, exclusive gallery. Following the tour, we have some free time to explore the rest of this Historic Dockyard at leisure.

Day 3: After breakfast, we head to the historic city of **Canterbury**, renowned for its atmospheric old streets, medieval walls, and the magnificent Canterbury Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the rich history and stunning architecture at your own pace, perhaps taking a guided tour of the cathedral or wandering through the charming shops and cafes. In the afternoon, we continue to **Faversham**, a picturesque town with nearly 500 listed buildings and home to the Shepherd Neame Brewery, Britain's oldest brewer.
