Day 3: We continue to head north into the Perthshire Highlands and enjoy a morning stop to the Highland town of **Aviemore**, here we will have plenty of free time. We then venture further North to **Dornoch**, we have time here to have lunch and to explore its many unique shops and beautiful scenery. Marvel at spectacular Highland scenery before arriving in **Thurso**, Britain's most northerly mainland town, for a 3 night stay.

Day 4: After breakfast, we travel to the **Castle and Gardens of Mey**, once the much-adored home of the Queen Mother, who saved it from ruin in 1952. With glorious views across the Pentland Firth towards Orkney, the castle is kept as it was when the Queen Mother was in residence. No visit to this region would be complete without a visit to the famous landmark, **John O'Groats**.

Day 5: Enjoy the highlight of the tour, a voyage of discovery through time itself on a coach guided tour of the **magical Orkney Islands**. Here, you will have the chance to see the World Heritage sites of Skara Brae, the Standing Stones of Stenness and the Ring of Brodgar, plus Scapa Flow, the Churchill

Day 7: This morning we continue our journey South, and visit the pretty conservation village of **Luss**, which is situated on the western shore of Loch Lomond. We then visit Moffat, nestled in the heart of Southern Scotland. **Moffat** is a vibrant, bustling town, explore its many shops, cafés and restaurants. We then head to our last overnight hotel in Haydock.
